D. The voting rules are:

Only original ballots will be accepted. Copies of ballots will NOT be accepted.

Write-in candidates are acceptable. If you are writing in a candidate, please verify that they are both eligible to serve and will agree to serve if elected.

You may vote for one, two, or three candidates.

Any ballot that contains more than three votes will NOT be counted.

Only one vote per candidate will be accepted.

Any candidate receiving fewer than 10 votes will be disqualified.

These rules will be printed on the ballot.

- E. Ballots are due in the Club's post office box before Saturday, September 11. Ballots must be returned through the postal service using the return envelope, to which the proper postage must be affixed. Ballots will NOT be accepted at the Club Office.
- F. Ballots will be retrieved from the Post Office Box on Saturday morning, September 10. Counting will begin at 9:00am on Sunday, September 11, at the Community Center.
- G. Anyone willing to assist in the counting of ballots, please contact Gretchen at the office. We need at least 4 people to count ballots. It should take about 90 minutes.

Each candidate may designate one person to observe the counting process.
