DISCUSSION FROM THE FLOOR:

- 1. Irene Genther reported on the Co-Gen. She inquired about the money spent from the account. C. Gangaware reported that it was used for additional water testings. She reported that Exxon took over the CoGen in July. Matt Cohen is the new manager. She will let us know if they will keep the advisory committee. G. Makovec asked for her to possibly interpret the test results that the CoGen have reported.
- 2. Joe Desien commented on the picnic. He felt that the food was good but that there were not enough servers. Committee will be looking into things to corrected next time.
- 3. Joe Mikruk asked for his letter to be read. P. Whitley read his letter to the board. C. Gangaware said that the shed is on his property and that the club has never held sheds to follow the setback requirements.
