DISCUSSION FROM THE FLOOR:

- 1. Lorraine Drosdak reported hearing ATVs running on Lake Drive several times at 2:30 AM. This is a little too late and asked if there isn't a rule about this. Board reported that there is a rule restricting the hours and will start by sending out an email reminding the membership of the rule.
- 2. Lenny Ciszek questioned planting trees at the beaches. Are we going to have a form to pick what kind of tree and how much? Thanked the board for moving the diggers. G. Demetriades said that they will come up with a plan. S. Daderko questioned what they were looking for . Discussion held.
- 3. Renee DeMelfi asked if on Dock A at Eastwood that the first 4 slips to be non-powered boats. She said that dock A was moved toward their property and has caused a problem when swimming in front of their property.
- 4. Joe Pilla asked to be permitted to have his ice cream cart come back into the lake this summer. He also expressed an interested in using the old coffee shop as a home base for his ice cream cart. This will be discussed at the March workshop. G. Demetriades said that the board has talked about making a fitness room where the coffee shop is now. Several members expressed concern about losing the kitchen that is used every week and for parties. The audience was assured that the library would stay. Discussion held. It was recommended that Joe Pilla drop off a proposal to be addressed at the workshop.
- 5. Charlie Sincavage asked what is the status of fixing the holes on Lake Drive created by the water authority. G. Demetriades did talk to Bob Demyanovich and he will again. Charlie said that is should be cold patched now and fill in with a permanent patch later in the spring. B. Davidovich said that maintenance is working on docks until there is warmer weather and then they will do potholes.
- 6. Charlie Sincavage asked if the board received was hiring an outside firm for removing and trimming trees. They have not.
- 7. Charlie Sincavage asked if they looked into renting a tar machine to do the cracks. Discussion held about how many guys it would take to run the machine.
- 8. Charlie Sincavage asked if the board realized that there is a slope run at Meadow Run. G. Demetriades said that we are receiving a bid from Radocha.

- 9. Charlie Sincavage asked if the board had any questions of the cost of the roads that he recently submitted for the board to review. No questions from the board. They explained that they were waiting on the loan and then go to the bidders. Charlie said that they could go to the bidders now just using the total square yards.
- 10. Renee DeMelfi asked if there were plans to repair the dip in front of Derlunas. It is scheduled to be repaired as soon as possible.

1. The board discussed the new fine schedule. Cy Fulton read the new rule. Charlie Sincavage questioned why we were changing the rule. Discussion held. A motion was made by S. Daderko, seconded by B. Davidovich, to approve the new Fine and Penalties rule. All in favor, motion passed.
